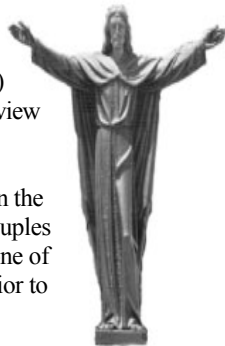

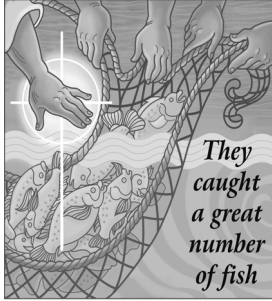
Preparation can begin before or after the birth of your child.

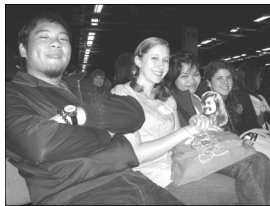
On Saturday, January 30, 2010, 2 pm at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Joseph, the above couples celebrated their wedding anniversaries.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Mon, Feb 8: Jerome Emiliani, Priest; Josephine Bakhita, Virgin.

Jerome Emiliani, died 1537 of the plague; Venetian soldier whose conversion led to the founding of the Clerks Regular Somascha, today numbering about 500 members; dedicated to the poor and the education of youth; patron of orphans and abandoned children.

Josephine Bakhita, died 1921; young Sudanese girl sold into slavery, brought to Italy and, while serving as a nanny, was sent to live with the Canossian Sisters in Venice; there she was baptized and eventually was granted her freedom; in 1896 she joined the Canossian Daughters of Charity. She died after a long and painful illness. Her dying words were, "Our Lady! Our Lady!" This memorial has been newly included in the Universal Calendar.

Wed, Feb 10: Scholastica, Virgin.

Scholastica, died c. 543 at Monte Cassino; twin sister of St. Benedict, "She could do more because she loved more" (Gregory the Great, *The Dialogues*); eventually interred in the same grave with her brother, St. Benedict; invoked against storms; patron saint of Benedictine nunneries.

Thurs, Feb 11: Our Lady of Lourdes.

According to St. Bernadette, the visionary at Lourdes in 1858, the Virgin Mary proclaimed herself "The Immaculate Conception"; patroness of Portugal and of the Philippines.

Pope John Paul II has designated 11 February as World Day of the Sick.
