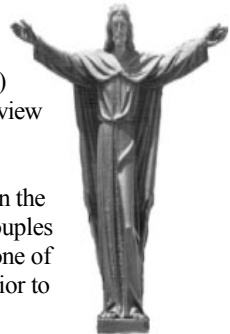
Infant Baptisms

Liturgical Tidbits

GOSPEL CYCLES

Since Vatican II we have heard three times as many Gospel readings as before. (This is also true of the epistles). This is because we now have three cycles. So the readings, except for certain feast days, occur only once every three years. The three cycles each feature one of the evangelists: A is the year of Matthew, B the year of Mark, C the year of Luke. St. John's gospel is read during the Easter season and on some specific other days throughout the year. On Good Friday we always hear St. John's account of the Passion. The Passion reading on Palm Sunday rotates among the other evangelists according to the cycle.

Mary Cruz Menacho, wife of Luis Menacho (deceased) was born on September 5, 1910 in Spain. She is the loving mother of three children, two sons and one daughter (deceased), and a beloved grandmother to seven grandchildren, eleven great children and one great, great grandchild.

In 1913, Mary and her family sailed from Spain for sixty-three days around Cape Horn, South America bound for Hawaii. An interesting fact, Mary's future husband, Luis and his family, sailed on the same ship. Her parents worked on a sugar cane plantation in Hawaii. And at the age of seven, Mary worked with her family to cultivate the sugar can fields. In 1919, having waited for a ship for three months, the family sailed to San Francisco and took the train to Santa Clara.

Mary and Luis became acquainted in Santa Clara and were married there in 1929. They purchased the first home built on Los Arboles Avenue in Sunnyvale where Mary still resides. As a chartered parishioner, Mary became an usher at the 5 pm vigil Mass on Saturday and served faithfully for thirty-five years. Mary's signature as an usher was to offer a "thank you" to every parishioner as she passed the offertory basket. Her favorite hobbies were crocheting, gardening, cooking and walking. Now Mary enjoys her family and grandchildren and is looking forward to celebrating her 100th birthday with them.
