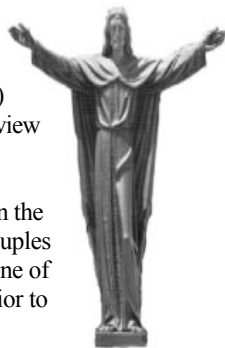
## Infant Baptisms

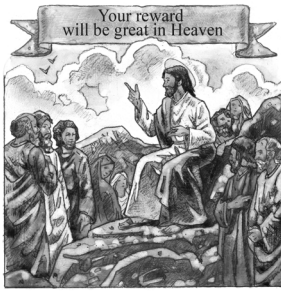
Preparation can begin before or after the birth of your child.

### Liturgical Tidbits

#### FALSE PROPHETS, TRUE PROPHETS

In Deuteronomy today we hear that God's very words will fill the mouth of a true prophet, but a false prophet will, in a manner of speaking, put mere mortal words into God's mouth. In Mark's Gospel, we see Jesus teaching and healing as a true prophet, one filled with the authority of God's own voice, the Holy One of God. The whole history of our Church is filled with both true and false prophets. But in today's Gospel we learn that Jesus' fame spread because he taught with authority; he wasn't an authority because he was popular or famous. We also learn from him, in his desert temptation confrontations with Satan, that anyone can quote scripture, even against God's purposes. And today we hear that his authority was not like that of the scribes, who held the official positions of religious authority in his day. Our work is to do our best to discern the true prophets in our midst, and to be true prophets as well. The psalmist tells us how to do this: by not hardening our hearts when God speaks. If we truly listen to God, it will be God's very words filling our mouths.

### **SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

Baptism is the first sacrament of Christian initiation. All sacraments are celebrations of Christ's love at work in our lives as members of a community of faith. All sacraments ideally take place in a gathering of the parish community. For this reason the parish has set three dates each month for infant baptism and families are requested to select one of these dates/times: first Saturday of the month (11 am), third Sunday of the month, (10 am Mass); fourth Sunday of the month, (1 pm). Family/friend celebrations/parties are appropriate after these baptism dates/times, or any time after.



Parents of infants/young children are asked to: (1) contact the parish to set a time to speak to one of the priests; (2) register for and attend a baptism information presentation on the first Saturday of each month (**the next class is on February 4, 2012**) at 10 am - alcove area of Farana Center - one hour; select one of the three monthly days/times for Baptism of their children.

### **SPONSORS**

At least one sponsor (godfather/godmother) is required, and must be a baptized/confirmed and practicing Catholic. Sponsors/godparents must attend a baptism workshop - either in this parish or their own. Please direct all questions regarding sponsors for Baptism to the priest with whom you speak during the pre-baptism interview.

### **FEASTS OF THE WEEK**

#### **Mon, Jan 31: John Bosco, Priest.**

John Bosco, died 1888 at Turin; founded (1859) the Salesians, today numbering over 17,500; dedicated to educating youth; with St. Mary Mazzarello, founded the Salesian Sisters; a pioneer in vocational training; patron of editors.

#### **Wed, Feb 2: The Presentation of the Lord.**

This feast, originating in 4th c. Jerusalem, came to be celebrated in Rome by the middle of the 5th c. under the title "Feast of the Meeting"; known also as Candlemas Day.

#### **Thurs, Feb 3: Blaise, Bishop, Martyr; Ansgar, Bishop.**

**Blaise**, believed martyred in the persecution of Licinius, early 4th c.; bishop of Sebaste in Armenia; associated with the healing of throats; venerated as well by the Eastern Church.

**Ansgar**, died 865 at Bremen; O.S.B. missionary to Denmark and Sweden; bishop of Hamburg; great preacher and administrator; known as the "Apostle of the North"; patron of Denmark, Germany, and Iceland.

#### **Sat, Feb 5: Agatha, Virgin, Martyr.**

Agatha, died probably under Decius (c. 251) in Sicily; patroness of Palermo and Catania; invoked for protection against volcanic eruptions and fires.
